CHANGING YOUR MOUSE SPEED

Purpose: To adjust the double-click speed for your mouse.

Windows 98 – (Windows ME & XP in Parenthesis)

LC = Left Click

RC = Right Click

DLC = Double Left Click

1 – To open Mouse Properties

2 - **LC** Start

3 - **LC** Settings (Windows XP Skip #3 go to # 4)

4 - **LC** Control Panel (Windows XP from control panel **LC** printers and other hardware.)

5 - **DLC** Mouse

6 – Make sure you are working in the Buttons tab. (On some Windows XP go to the Activities tab)

7 – **LC** the button configuration you want.

8 – Under the Double Click Speed, **LC** and hold down on the slider while you select the speed for **DLC** by dragging the slider back and forth.

(For Windows ME & Windows XP you can turn on the Click lock so it stays where you want.) (On some Windows XP use the Buttons tab.)

TIP

To test the speed, double-click the image in the test area.

You can also check the box that will adjust for right or left handed use of the mouse. (On some Windows XP use the buttons tab)
